Europeana Newspapers: Aims and Objectives

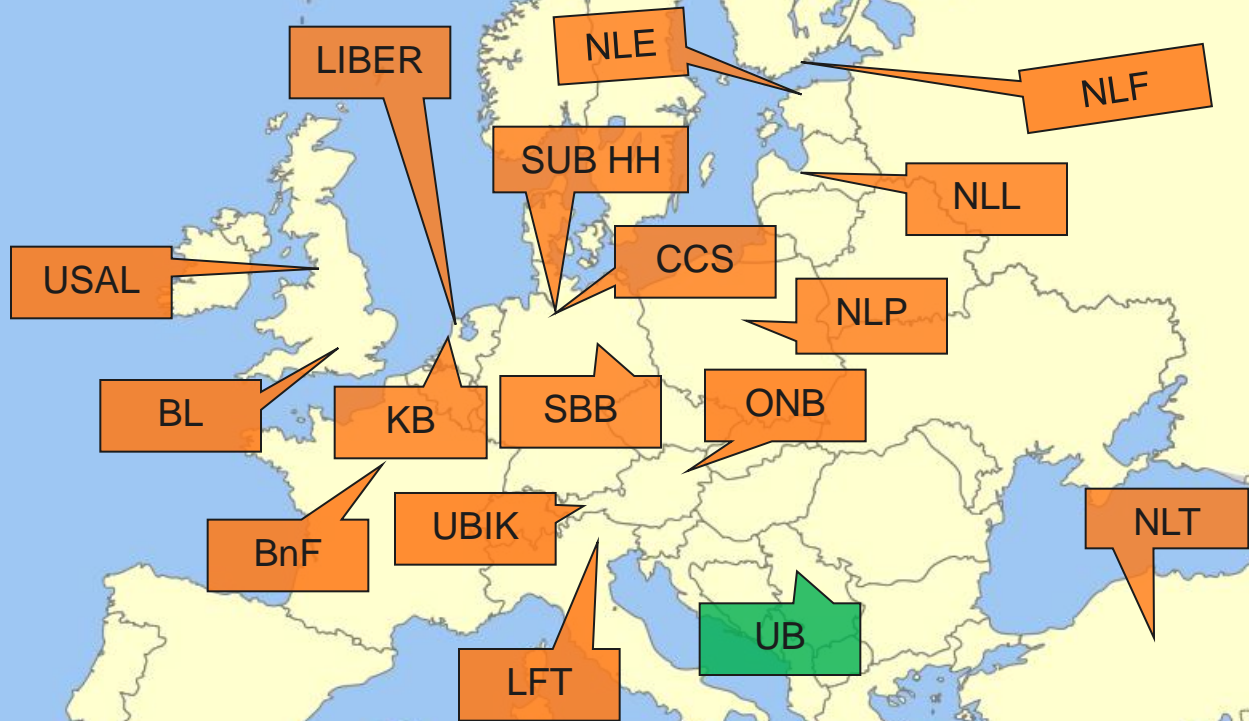
- Aims at the aggregation and refinement of newspapers for *The European Library* and *Europeana*.
- Will use refinement methods for OCR, OLR (article segmentation), and named entity (NER) and class recognition
- The libraries participating in the project will provide around 18 million digitised newspaper pages to Europeana
- Further libraries will be encouraged to contribute newspapers to Europeana and TEL by the project

Project Consortium

- 17 partners from 12 countries
 - National libraries
 - University libraries
 - Others (association, private company)
- External partners and stakeholders:
 - Involvement of libraries outside the project consortium
 - Various stakeholders engagement (users, technical experts, typography experts, historians etc.)

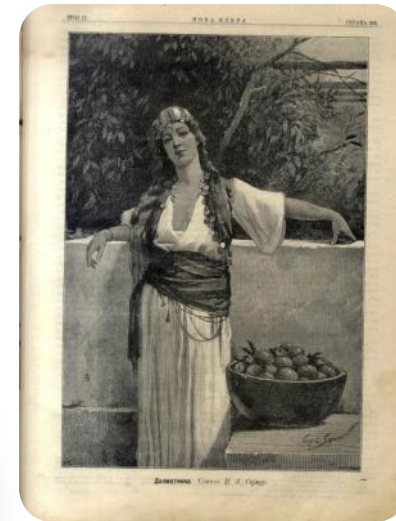
University Library in Belgrade: Role

- Involved in all segments of the project
- Adds 380.000 pages of newspapers published in Serbia before 1941.
- Librarians from Belgrade will participate in developing EDM and finding new ways to make Europeana content more usable and more used.
- aims at creating innovative digital objects that will catch attention of users and bring back into focus the quality historical content.
