




Are You Meeting Your Students' E-book Needs?



48% would "very often" to "often" choose E over P if available*






What % of your budget is for e-books?







Value of AC




list price of used titles

ebrary and Summon

- Increase access
 - Up to 400,000 e-books discoverable from library's "front door"
 - Customized to reflect ebrary holdings
- Increase relevance
 - Indexed to chapter level full-text
 - Useful for phrase searching not in metadata
- Increase visibility of ebooks
 - Students surveys demonstrate that while there is awareness that library provides ebooks, they often don't know where to find them
- Save time

- EBL acquisition confirmed in May '13

- 3 user model active
- User Title Recommendations
- ProQuest Integration active
- UI and PDA area update
- e-Approval system



ebrary's Solution

- More publisher agreements than any other aggregator (~ 600)
- More models
 - Subscription = critical mass and unlimited users
 - PA/PDA = unlimited users or single user with Extended Access (3 user soon)
 - STL: Non-ownership model avoids speculative purchasing and saves on ILL
- Full-text feed to Serials Solutions for Summon
- Up to 50% discount off Publisher Packs
- Coming March integration with ProQuest
