1. Introduction

- The National Library of Korea (NLK)
 - The comprehensive depository of the nation's books and documents
 - To collect and preserve the intellectual cultural heritage of the nation and to pass on to the future generations
- The 21st Century, New Information Age
 - To connect the analogue resources and digital information based on the hybrid type paradigm
 - To include full text DB, national table of contents DB, article index and abstract DB, government collection DB, materials for the visually impaired DB, etc
 - Cyber National Digital Library currently in service
- Construction of the National Digital Library (NDL)
 - To collect, process, and preserve the digital information resources

2.1 Full Text DB

Overview

 Digitize selected academic and informational materials of the National Library of Korea (NLK) to reduce the gaps among regions in terms of getting access to the digital materials by providing information fast



- Materials in NLK that were published 5 years ago
- Academic and informational materials













2.1 Full Text DB

Copyright Holding Contents

- Access from the National Library of Korea Homepage (http://www.nl.go.kr)
- Access from the Cyber National Digital Library Homepage (http://www.dlibrary.go.kr)
- Unlimited access to the materials that are free of their copyrights
- Copyright-holding 160,664 volumes, 50,123,962 pages are only allowed in those libraries having agreements with Copy and Transfer Center for their copyright compensation fee.



2.2 National Table of Contents DB



- All materials in the National Library of Korea
- Monographs and Academic Journals
- Excluding reference materials and single-item materials such as long novels and plays
- Including multi-item materials such as poems, short stories, essays



2.4 Union Cataloging DB

Overview

- Integrated DB for collections of public libraries, libraries in government organizations, and libraries for the visually impaired.
- Include KERIS' union catalogs for universities
- To eliminate the unnecessary redundant processes and to establish standardized catalogs

• 18,310,000 items





4.1 Direction of the Construction of the NDL

Creation of a New ECO-Frendly and cutting Edge NDL building

- Location : In front of the National Library of Korea, Banpo-dong, Seocho-gu, Seoul, Korea
- Scale: 38,013,39 square meters

 (3 ground floors and 5 underground floors)
- Facilities: Spaces for collecting, creation, preservation and user services of digital resources, offices, book stacks, underground parking lots
- Book stacks capacity: 12 million volumes
- Duration of project : 2002-2008 (7 years)
- Total budget : 115,200,000,000 KRW

Gateway for digital knowledge resource


- In consideration of user-friendly system



Openness


- 1. Integrated management of the high quality resources of digital libraries that are scattered in domestic and abroad






