CABI – a century of science

- The Entomological Research Committee established in 1910
- CABI was formed in 1928 from a number of research bureaux
- Charged with **research and information provision** in areas related to the *applied* life sciences



CABI – A modern organization

- Not-for-profit, intergovernmental organization
- Multi-national (324 employees in 12 offices)
- Publishing (7 million abstracts on CAB Abstracts, 77 new books in 2006, 143 reprints)
- Bioservices (Microbial Services testing, supply, identification, preservation and patenting and Fungal Products)
- ID (K4D, Commodities, Invasives, Biopesticides and Microbial Capacity)

CAB Abstracts

- comprehensive and conclusive coverage of Applied Life Sciences (5.3 million records)
- essential coverage of international and non-journal literature
- Over 269,500 new records in 2007
- Increasing focus on key topics (Climate Change, Biofuels, Biodiversity)

CAB Abstracts

Key Developments

- Improvement in Environmental coverage
- Improvement in Invasive Species coverage
- Substantial growth in content (175,000 records for Publication Year 2000, more than 230,000 for PY 2007)
- Growth in content
 - Filling in any remaining gaps
 - Acquiring new journals
 - Increasing book coverage



CAB Abstracts Archive

- Entire CAB Abstracts backfile from 1910 1972
 1,800,000 records = 600 print volumes = 40 metres of shelving
- Issues of contemporary importance i.e. avian influenza, blue tongue and climate change
- Unique source for hard-to-find research
- Key to evidence-based research and historical context
- Catalogue of international and non-journal material



Global Health

- World's only dedicated Public Health Database
- Large dataset of 1.3 million records
- Key coverage of topics like XDR-TB and Chikungya
- International and multi-disciplinary coverage
- 3000 unique journals not covered by Embase or Medline
- Uniquely positioned tool to respond to increasing Population movement and Global Warming
- Entire Global Health Archive from 1910 1983
 800,000 records = 200 print volumes = 20 metres of shelving



Global Health

Key Developments

- Differentiation
 - from CAB Abstracts 38,000 unique records in 2007
 - from Medline 3000 journals not taken by Medline, of which 270 core health ones taken cover-to-cover
- Substantial growth in content (47,000 records for Publication Year 2000, 90,000 for PY 2007)
- A focus on promotion in 2008 comparisons, blogging, conferences, listservs, etc.

Historic collection of 2,800 CAB Reviews from 1930 - 2003



CAB eBooks

- Dynamic, subscription based front file (2005+) and static, one-off purchase back file (2000-2004)
- Subject coverage and metadata fully complementary to CAB Abstracts – key access point
- Over 400 titles and 7,000 records (front file); over 240 titles (back list)
- Unprecedented granularity; all titles indexed and available as chapters
- Key titles for CAB Abs core market
- E-books displayed as a PDF
