In 2001 publishing in the journals from JCR list became a criterion for financing researchers by the Ministry of Science

Education in University Library



- 2005: 7 courses with groups of academic librarians, 120 participants (Citation in SCI data bases)
- 2008: 14 courses with groups of academic librarians, researchers, professors, students and most important groups of doctoral students, near 500 participants
- 2009: panel discussion with 30 participants (academic librarians) and in the future plan for at least 200 doctoral students
