



- www.crossref.org
- Foundation, 300 publishers, over 300 affiliates/agents/other organisations
- Over 12M records, over 9000 journals
- "Digital switchboard" to find correct URL of a document (journal, article, abstract, reference list, TOC, etc)
- DOI, digital object identifier
- Resolves DOI into URL
- No dead links
- Linking agreements between providers easy

OpenURL (1)

- library.caltech.edu/openurl
- The "appropriate copy" problem
- Context-sensitive reference linking
- Open international standard, NISO
- Syntax for packaging metadata & identifiers (DOI, ISSN, etc)
- Syntax for pointing to a user-specific resolver

OpenURL (2)

- Identifier & user information resolved into links
 - Publisher fulltext
 - Aggregator fulltext or abstract
 - Local library collection database
 - ILL, document delivery
 - Eprint archive, grey literature
 - etc...
 - Determined by needs of local institution / library

Statistics

- Accessed from admin.metapress.com
- Use contact person's "admin" password
- COUNTER level 1
- No of fulltext downloads
- Per month and per journal
- Administration of OpenURL links

 - Continued access on server
