- Institutional Repositories:

Pre-prints, post-prints, preserving our intellectual capital

- Journal / Publisher access:
 - Green can archive pre-print and post-print
 - *Blue* can archive post-print (i.e., final draft post-refereeing)
 - Yellow can archive pre-print (i.e., pre-refereeing)
 - White archiving not formally supported



Open Access Journals - e.g.,

- DOAJ Directory of Open Access Journals Univ. Lund, Sweden - 2643 open access journals -<u>http://www.doaj.org/</u> - Categorized, searchable links to free, full text, quality controlled scientific and scholarly journals in all subjects and languages
- Now 795 journals are searchable at article level
- Now 131113+ articles are included
