EMILIANO ZAPATA, 1901-1919

This collection comprises documentation related to the activities of Emiliano Zapata and the Liberation Army of the South. It consists mainly of correspondence exchanged between the headquarters and the camps and regional commands. Documents include requests for economic aid; guarantees to people for jobs and food; complaints of abuses; reports, promotions, and notifications to the troops and brigades, as well as information on pay. The documentation also includes acts or proceedings on revolutionary and civil trials; correspondence with municipal of State authorities in connection with problems of land, water, control of finance, trade, etc.; and information concerning the revolutionary Convention sovereign.

POST-WAR EUROPE: REFUGEES, EXILE AND RESETTLEMENT, 1945-1950

This online archive delivers essential primary sources for the study and understanding of the challenges facing the European peoples in the aftermath of World War II. It covers the politics and administration of the post war refugee crisis in Europe well as the day-to-day survival of the refugees themselves. Although the War in Europe ended officially in May 1945, the struggle continued for the millions of homeless people who had been displaced as a result of military action, deportation into labour or concentration camps, local racism and discrimination or the relocation of national borders. The burden of the refugee problem taxed the Allied governments and Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) relief groups in their attempts to administer, feed and house a moving people searching for their lost families and a permanent home. A rapid repatriation programme was organised but many Displaced Persons (DPs) could not or would not return to their homelands. Emigration programmes struggled against the political and economic realities of the post-war world. The resolution of this humanitarian crisis was a complex and often painful process.

THE MIDDLE EAST ONLINE: IRAQ, 1914-1974

Iraq 1914-1974 offers the widest range of original source material from the Foreign Office, Colonial Office, War Office and Cabinet Papers from the Anglo-Indian landing in Basra in 1914 through the British Mandate in Iraq of 1920-32 to the rise of Saddam Hussein in 1974. Here major policy statements are set out in their fullest context, the minor documents and marginalia revealing the workings of the mandate administration, diplomacy, treaties, oil and arms dealing. Topics covered include: The Siege of Kut-al-Amara, The War in Mesopotamia and the capture of Baghdad in 1917, Introduction of the British Mandate, and the installation of King Faisal in 1921. The British administration in Baghdad, Gertrude Bell, advisor to the British administration, in both reports and memos, The Arab Uprising of 1920, Independence, and Iraq's membership of the League of Nations in 1932, Coups d'etat in the 1930s and 1940s. The Baghdad Pact of 1956 and the military coup of 1958 leading to the establishment of a republic, The Cold War and Soviet intervention in Iraq, Kurdish unrest and the war in Kurdistan, Oil concessions and oil exploration, The Rise of Ba'athism and Saddam Hussein, The USSR-Iraq Treaty of Friendship in 1972, Iran-Iraq relations.

What You're Loving, What's Upcoming

It's said that in a recession, people opt for old-world comforts. While in the electronic world there isn't much that's old world, the librarians who responded to this year's call for best-database nominations name some mainstays that are likely to inspire some e-nostalgia. *Consumer Reports*, *CultureGrams*, and *Guide to Reference* are resources we've relied upon in libraries for years, and their electronic incarnations are now bringing solid, back-in-the-day reference to the Wikipedia generation. There are some whippersnappers listed here too—game-changers, even—such as online newsstand Zinio and JIVE, the Journal of Video Experiments. In the middle is the broad-and-butter of reference these days: journal and ebook databases that patrons today expect as standard and that librarians can't imagine how they lived without.

If it's been a while since library school, or if your reference class was a blur of almanacs, encyclopedias, and citation indexes, take a look at Michael Bemis's guide to databases, p. 16. Describing resources including the *United States Government Internet Directory* and *Fulltext Sources Online*, he makes figuring out which database to use and where to find it a breeze.

 Gale's been busy this year. Its archival offerings are burning at the seams, with the company recently launching Nineteenth Century Collections Online, an archive of period documents and images that follows a popular resource covering the prior century. Gale was also lauded by respondents for its new archives of popular magazines: *Liberty Magazine Historical Archive*, 1924–1950 and *National Geographic Magazine Archive*, 1888–1994. But an old favorite takes top honors: Gale Virtual Reference Library, or GVRL, which Lura Sarborn of St. Paul School Library, NH, says "allows me to re-create my reference collection, both back- and frontlist titles, in digital form." Our review of the database relaunch (1/2/12) noted that it allows librarians to build collections title by title, just like they are used to doing with print books. The database offers more than 7000 digital reference titles from 80 publishers, and the upgrade made searching easier than ever, with granular options for advanced users and keyword searching of a broader range of fields for novices. Has reference usage been lagging? Gale helps there, too. The GVRL's "Promote Your Gale eBooks" page offers search widgets that can be used on the library's homepage or elsewhere. MARC records so that ebooks can be integrated into the online catalog, and other promotional goodies such as linked book cover images.

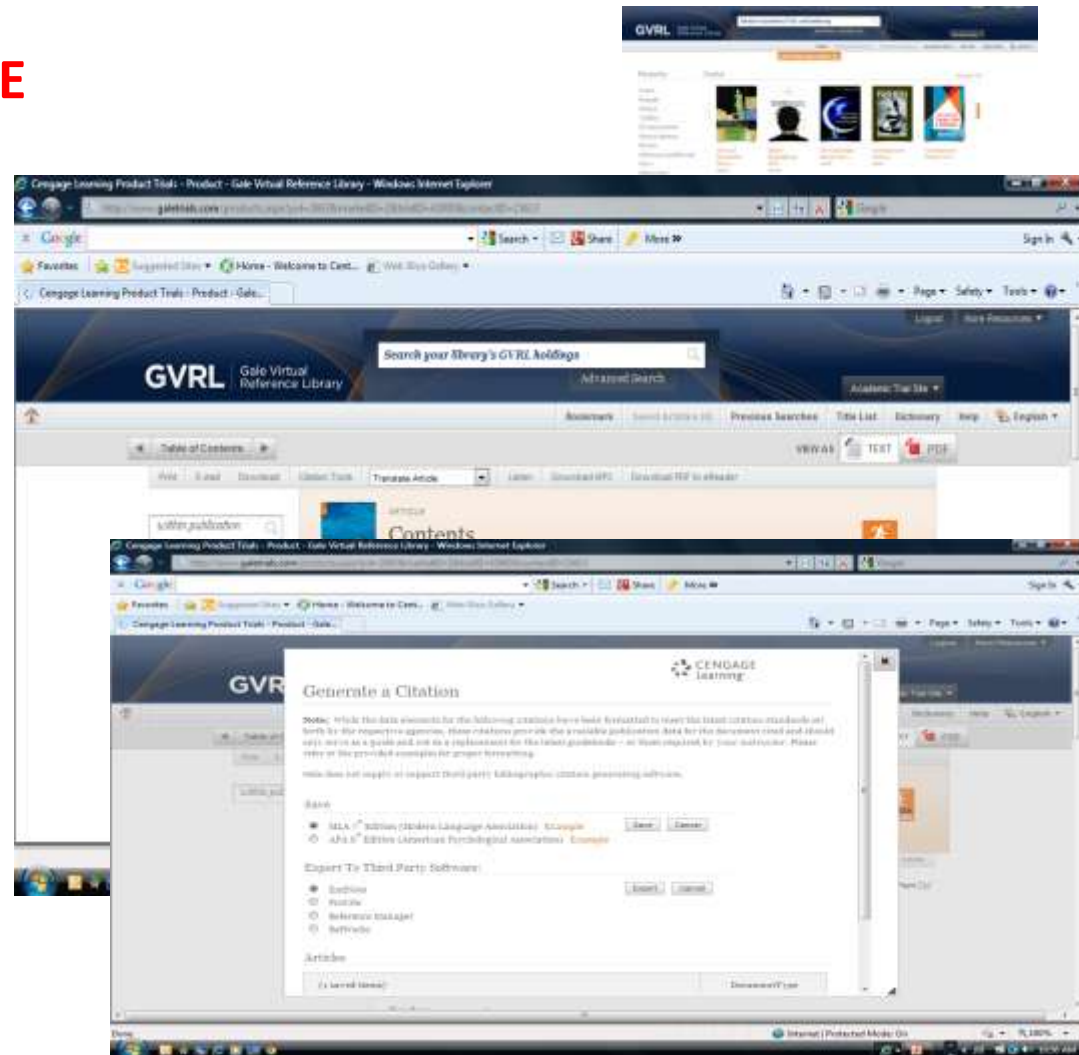

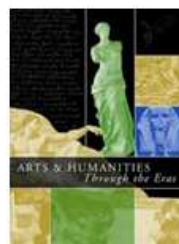

put up until 1739, when the long enclosing wall was added. The place never actually fired a shot in anger, although its guns undoubtedly intimidated visiting vessels into paying the eighteen shillings levied to the fort's captain.

Today, though the fort is pretty dilapidated, it still offers plenty of interesting structures for poking around and great views across the channel and back down to St John's harbour. Rusting British cannons from the early 1800s point out to sea and down the channel, their threat long gone but still a dramatic symbol of their era. Elsewhere, the old powder magazine is still intact, though leaning precariously, and the stone buildings on the fort's

Runaway Bay
Quiet Runaway Bay features gleaming white-sand beaches that slope gently down into the turquoise sea. Great for calm swimming, Runaway Bay has fewer hotels to tidy up their "patch" of sand than the built-up Dickenson bay, and so is strewn with more seaweed and rocks. Still, it's a great place to wander in the gentle surf, though at the northern end much of the beach has been eroded by heavy swells.

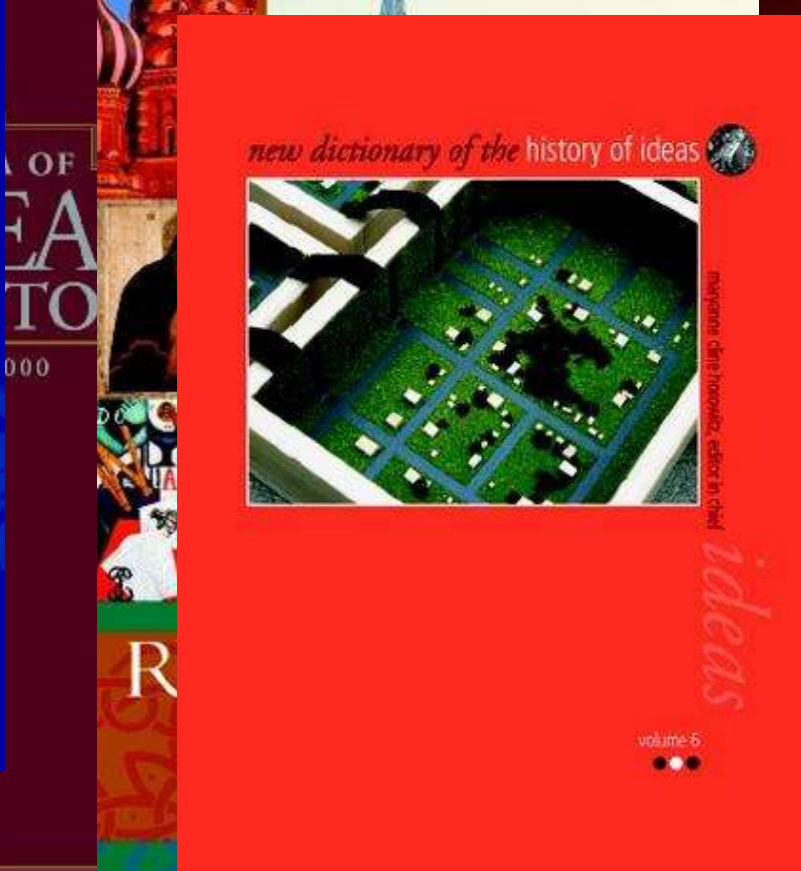
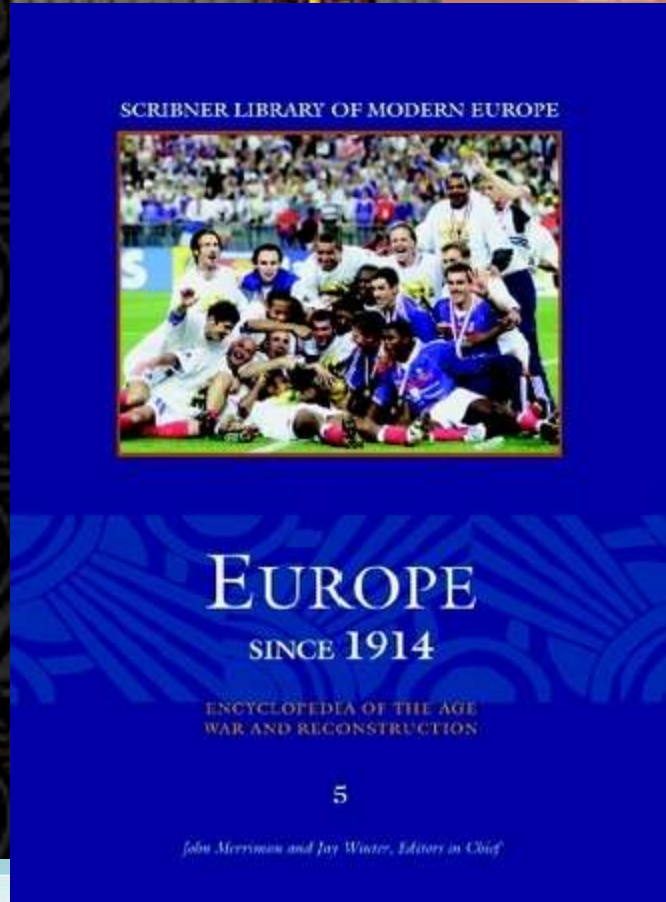
