Libraries become more attractive

Capture and analyze tables of contents: Find relevant chapters in more than 50 languages by searching in mother tongue

“Dandelon.com” is an international, open collaborative platform for libraries. They all scan tables of contents, run OCR, do machine indexing in various languages and store this content in their library systems. Therefore they use the “intelligentCAPTURE mobile” technology. Two million TOCs will be produced by end of 2013. A usage of 80-90 million via OPACs or discovery services can be forecasted for 2013. The current collection comprises 130 different languages of major subject areas. The German National Library is one of AGI’s most famous clients.

AGI develops the technological production and exchange platform named “dandelon.com”. Their “intelligentCAPTURE mobile” can capture content between shelves and is in use for tables of contents of books, current content for periodicals, entire digital books, periodicals and newspapers. Abbyy FineReader is used for OCR. The machine indexing module is combined with Google translator. Automatically more than 50 languages can be analyzed and indexed in quite many target languages. Example: Scan a Czech document and get German, English or other descriptors – from up to 80 books per hour.
