Option C is Correct. Hypomagnesaemia is a recognised but rare side effect of long-term proton pump inhibitor (PPI) medication. This can cause a prolonged QT interval with resultant torsades de pointes. This is important, as PPIs are frequently prescribed for gastric protection in many cardiac patients on long-term aspirin.

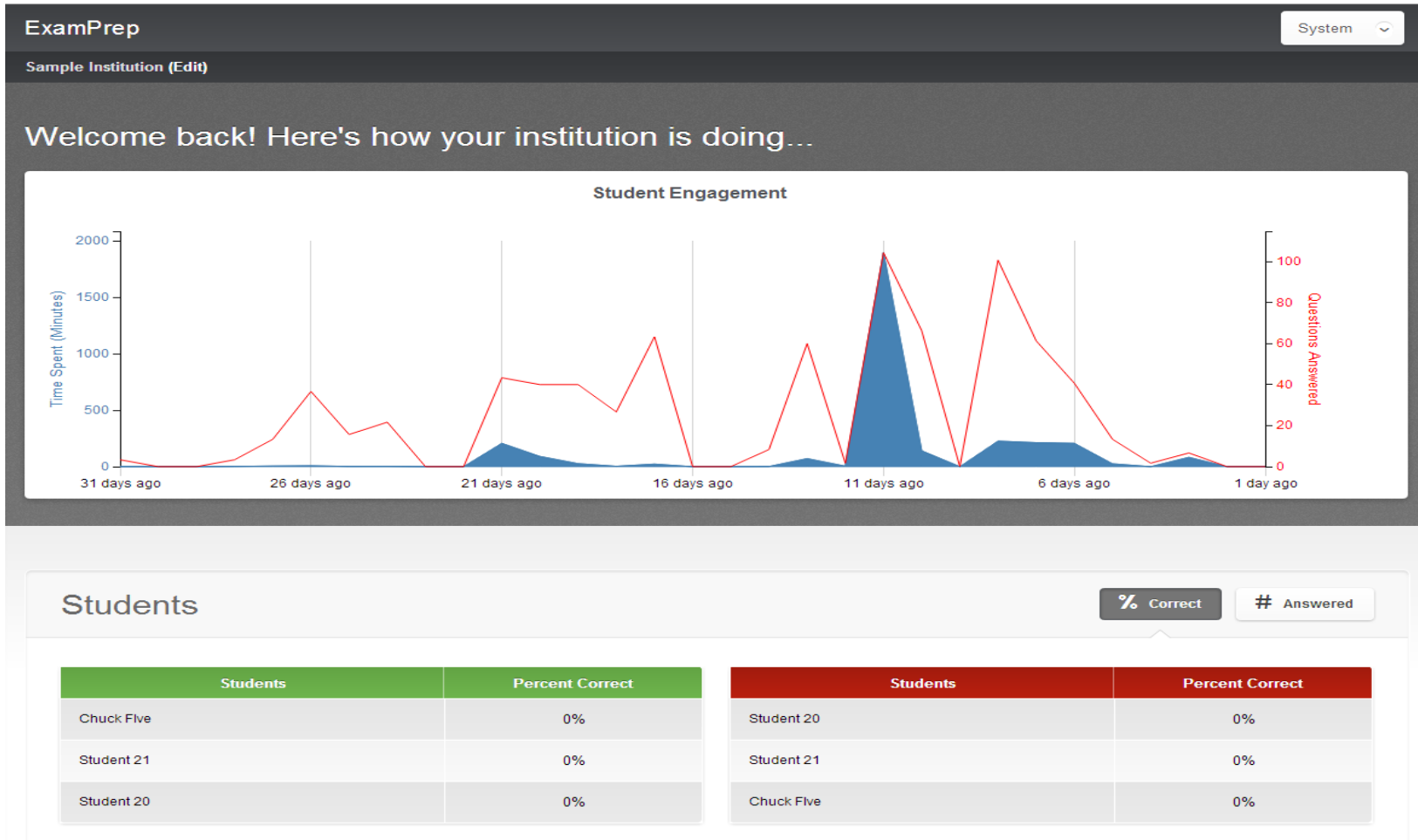
Option A is Incorrect. Hypocalcaemia can cause torsades de pointes but the cause is more likely to be hypomagnesaemia, which is a side effect of proton pump inhibitor (PPI) medication.

Option E is Incorrect. Hypothyroidism does not usually cause torsades de pointes.
